

Dear parent or carer,

As you know, 2024 is a big year for your child as they complete their VCE. We want them to succeed, and are doing absolutely everything we can to support them. As part of this, we've arranged <u>Edrolo</u> access for some of their subjects.

What is Edrolo?

Think of Edrolo as 24/7 learning support whenever your child needs it. There are video lessons, aligned to the study design and delivered by expert teachers. This means if your child misses a class, wants to review a topic, or is struggling to understand a concept, they can log on to Edrolo to watch these videos.

Plus there are 100s of practice exam questions with video solutions and sample answers so they can prepare for assessments and see example answers to maximise their exam marks. Their teachers will use the data from this to target support and make sure your child is on track with their studies throughout the year. Edrolo supplements what teachers do, meaning your child can access this additional support in the evening, at home or over the weekend when they most need it. Much like they might with a private tutor, but for a fraction of the cost.

Edrolo is available both as online resources and as a textbook, for various subjects, and is used by 95% of schools across Victoria, including the top 20 performing high schools, and we've carefully selected this resource as a way to give our students an advantage with their studies in 2024.

How your child can use Edrolo to boost their learning

Your child might be asked by their teachers to use Edrolo for:

- prescribed holiday homework
- pre-class work
- post-class consolidation (making sure they understand a concept)
- self-study, assessment preparation and exam revision

At any time, your child can access the supplementary course materials in Edrolo, use these to help them learn, and even flag content to revisit or where they need extra support from their classroom teacher.

How much does this additional support cost?

- Online course (per subject): \$47
- **Digital textbook** (with online access included): \$80 + optional \$32 hardcopy textbook (delivered to your home address).
 - o Delivery of hardcopy textbooks will be in late January 2024 for the commencement of classes

How do I pay for Edrolo?

You can easily and conveniently pay for your child's access to Edrolo via our school's dedicated Edrolo Payment Portal. As your child will be using Edrolo as a key resource in the subscribed subjects, please ensure payment is made early to ensure they can start using Edrolo immediately to kickstart their studies.

Payments can be made online through your child's Edrolo account from November 27 onwards. Step-by-step instructions on how to pay can be found <u>here</u>.

Please note: Payment is required by February 9, after this date access to the Edrolo resource will be restricted until payment.

How does my child activate their account?

If your child had Edrolo in 2023, their account will be active and you can log in with them as normal to pay through the Payment Portal as per Step 6 below.

If your child is NEW to Edrolo, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Go to www.edrolo.com.au/activate/nzr-edg
- 2. Enter your child's surname and check that it recognises their correct first name
- 3. Enter your child's school email address and choose a secure password that they will remember
- 4. Click 'Let me in'
- 5. Edrolo will send a confirmation email to the email address you used above head to this email and click the activation link.
- 6. Once you have signed into your account, click on the "**Pay now**" button in the top right-hand corner of your screen and follow the prompts.
